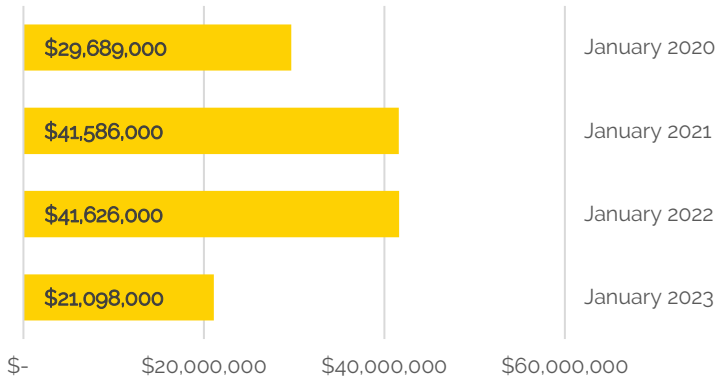

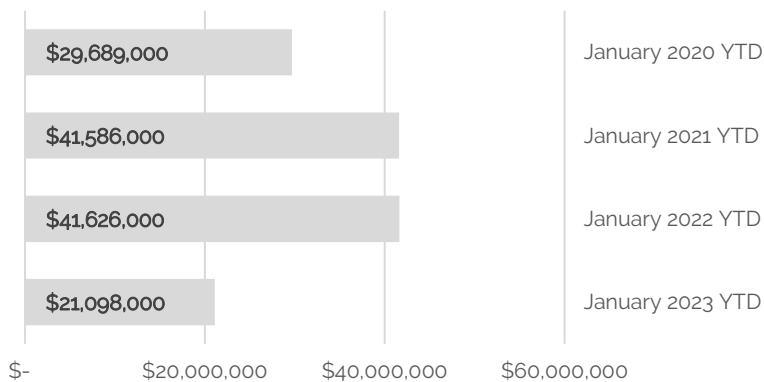
## BUILDING PERMIT STATISTICS

The South Region of Vancouver Island had 26 new residential building permits issued in January 2023, creating 48 new units with a total value of \$21,098,000. This January value equates to 100% of the total year to date. When looking back to 2022, we observed 67 permits issued in January for \$41,626,000.

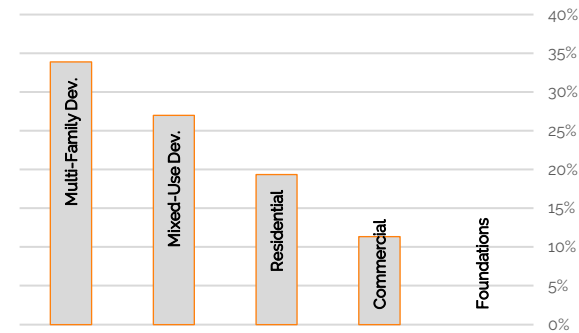

## RESIDENTIAL BUILDING PERMITS (MONTH)



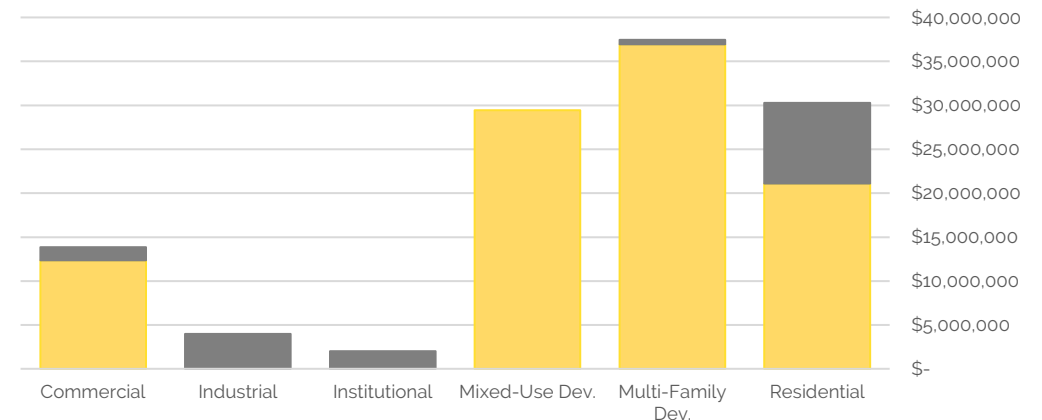

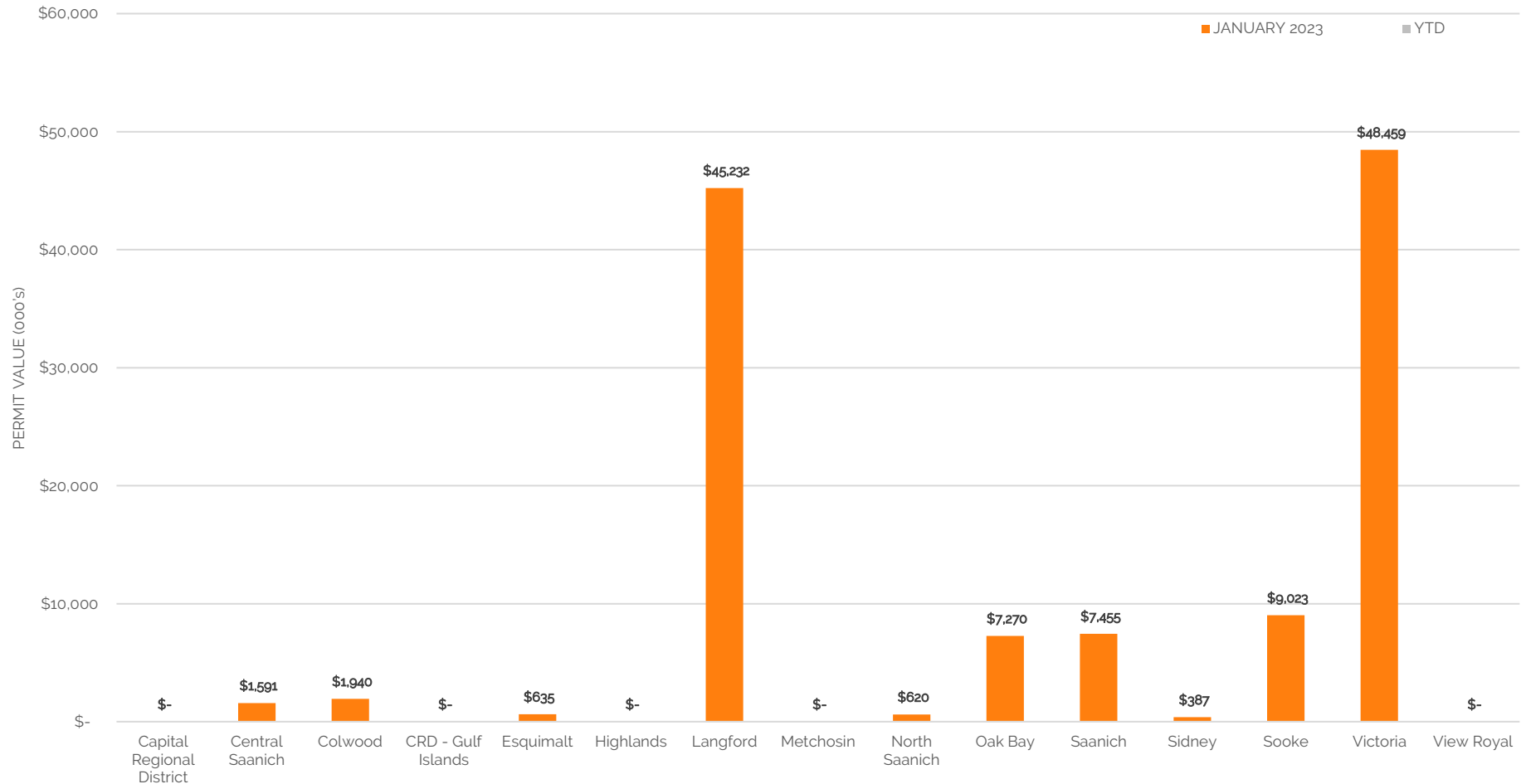
